4) Waiver of liability

If such a situation were to occur, it is understood that I would choose a representative arbitrator, Summer in the City would choose a representative arbitrator and the two arbitrators would select a neutral arbitrator to decide any and all claims, actions or disputes that could arise out of my participation with Summer in the City.
